UP govt got registration applications for 139 new projects

he total cost of the 126 projects is around Rs 3,800 crore, he added.

During the GIS-2023, 102 intents of investment worth Rs 18,000 crore were signed with the government of UP. These projects were all for investment in the tourism sector in Ayodhya. Even after the GBC, several proposals were received by the district administration and state government. Subsequently, the total investment proposed in

Ayodhya went up to Rs 45,402 crore which, if fully implemented, would generate employment for 53,472 people. The government has said that in addition to these projects, it has received registration applications for 139 new projects worth Rs 2,700 crore. Out of these, certificates have been issued to 87 projects worth Rs 1,650 crore. Another 25 projects have applied for renewal of which 21 projects have been issued renewal certificates, the official said.
