

# UP to set up pharma park

The Uttar Pradesh government is setting up a pharma park in Lalitpur, Bundelkhand, covering 1,472-acre across five villages, according to the Uttar Pradesh State Industrial Development Authority (UPSIDA).

The plan will unfold in two phases, with an initial focus on immediate development efforts covering 300 acre of land, the UPSIDA said. The villages identified for the survey include Saidpur (426 acre), Gadolikala (249 acre), Largan (239 acre), Karounda (116 acre), and Rampur (441 acre).

“The Pharma park and the acceleration of associated projects mark a strategic move by the UP government towards fostering industrial growth and economic development,” said Mayur Maheshwari, Chief Executive, UPSIDA.
