

## Uttar Pradesh Showcases Its Investment Landscape To Investors Of Japan's Yamanashi Prefecture

**Lucknow, January 16 (TNA)** The Embassy of India in Japan organised a landmark virtual interaction on Monday at the VCC Auditorium, Tokyo featuring the blooming partnership between India and Japan. In a detailed presentation, it was informed that in Uttar Pradesh, facilitation of investors is accelerated through digital governance and interventions, focusing on the entire investment life cycle management to enhance the business environment.

This dynamic exchange marks a significant stride in the India-Japan partnership, fostering collaborations and showcasing the diverse opportunities available to investors in the vibrant landscapes of Yamanashi Prefecture and Uttar Pradesh.
