

'Post-GBC, companies making UP their base'

Gautam Budh Nagar Is Most Preferred

Lucknow: Several manufacturing companies have set up their base in Uttar Pradesh, a fact that has emerged during the ground breaking ceremony (GBC 4.0) held recently, an official spokesperson said on Saturday. They pointed out that Gautam Budh Nagar has emerged as a preferred venue for manufacturing units.

Listing out some key projects the officials said that the Netherlands-based retail giant, Ingka is setting up a manufacturing unit with an investment of Rs 4,300 crore, providing employment opportunities for 500 people.

Similarly, the toy-making company Fun Zoo is investing Rs 1,052 crore in a toy park in Gautam Budh Nagar, creating the possibility of employment for over 20,000 people.

China's electronics company Haier is establishing a manufacturing plant in Gautam Budh Nagar with an investment of Rs 584.5 crore, generating more than 2,700 jobs.

Japan partnership precast solution provider company, is investing Rs 500 crore to set up a unit, offering employment opportunities for 500 people.

Meanwhile, Colorjet India, a digital textile inkjet



printer manufacturer, is establishing a unit with an investment of Rs 128 crore, creating 160 jobs. Officials said that manufacturing units are also coming up in other parts of the state.

Ashok Leyland has launched its e-vehicle plant in Lucknow with an investment of Rs 1,000 crore, creating job opportunities for 500 people. Likewise, Dalmia Cement is setting up a

manufacturing unit in Mirzapur with an investment of Rs 3,000 crore, aiming to employ 2,500 individuals.

Rimjhim Ispat, a steel company in Kanpur, is establishing a manufacturing factory with an investment of Rs 2,100 crore, providing employment opportunities for 500 people.

Similarly, Shree Cement is investing Rs 600 crore in a unit in Etah, generating employment for 245 individuals. The renowned food service company, Pakka, is establishing a unit in Ayodhya with an investment of Rs 550 crore, providing employment to 600 people. Kent RO in Sonbhadra is setting up a unit with an investment of Rs 500 crore, creating jobs for 700 individuals.

Moreover, JK Cement is establishing a factory in Prayagraj, generating employment for 250 people. Kanpur Plastipack is also investing Rs 300 crore in a unit in Kanpur Dehat, providing jobs for 125 people.

Meanwhile, Indorama, a Singapore and Indonesia-based company, is setting up a unit in Amethi with an investment of Rs 2,649 crore.
