Aid shot in arm for Yeida's med device park

Lucknow: UP government is offering one-time grantin-aid for common infrastructure facilities within the Medical Device Park being developed by Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority in Greater Noida, to equip the park with state-of-the-art equipment dedicated to cancer care, radiology, imaging, anaesthetics, cardiorespiratory support, pacemakers and cochlear implants.

A spokesperson said YE-IDA had invited expression of interest from companies to establish gamma radiation facilities, to be operated, maintained and managed in public-private partnership (PPP) mode.

The official said the Medical Device Park had been divided strategically into five segments to address various aspects of medical device manufacturing. The 350-acre park is near Jewar Airport in Sector 28 of Greater Noida, with invest-

ment of Rs 439 crore.
