The govt also provided for Rs 400 crore, proposed for the Atal Bihari Vajpayee Powerloom Electricity Flat Rate scheme, which aimed at uplifting handloom weavers as well as powerloom weavers. A budget of Rs 400 crore is proposed for the PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) scheme, under which a mega textile park has been approved for Lucknow-Hardoi, covering an area of approximately 1,000 acres. This park is expected to attract an investment of around Rs 10,000 to Rs 15,000 crore in the textile and garments sectors, creating opportunities for one lakh direct and two lakh indirect employment.
