

# CM: Good governance led to industrial development in UP

## Yogi Opens & Lays Foundation For 20 Projects

**Gorakhpur:** Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Thursday said that the development of Uttar Pradesh is crucial for a developed India and investments are important to achieve Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of development.

Speaking at an event at Gorakhpur Industrial Development Authority's (GIDA) sector 13 where the CM inaugurated and laid the foundation for 20 projects worth Rs 1,040 crore, he said: "For a developed India, UP's growth is crucial. Gorakhpur must also ascend the ladder of progress."

The CM attributed positive outcomes in industrial development and employment to improvement in law enforcement, effective governance, and selection of competent representatives.

"When intentions are pure, positive results follow. GI-

DA is reaching new heights, and the Gorakhpur Link Expressway will be completed soon, providing two routes to Lucknow," he said.

Yogi said concerted efforts were made in recent years to develop the region as an industrial hub. He mentioned investments in GIDA by companies like Varun Beverages, Keyan Distilleries, CP Milk, Tatva Plastics, Central Warehousing Corporation, India Autowheels, Balaji Processors, Rungta Industries, Kapila Agro Industries, and Singh Paper Project and said the projects would create approximately 5,000 jobs and generate income for young people.

The CM highlighted the

establishment of other industries in the GIDA area, including a 25-acre garment park, an 88-acre plastic park, and a flatted factory with a budget of Rs 34 crore. Additionally, the government plans to develop an industrial township sprawling on 5,500 acres in Dhuriyapar. "A proposal for a new cement factory has been received and land has been shown to the potential investor," he said. "After assuming office in 2014, PM Modi promised housing for every needy person. Nationally, 4 crore underprivileged individuals have received secure housing. In Uttar Pradesh, 56 lakh houses have been provided to the impoverished. GIDA's Kalesar residential project will of-

fer housing to people from all walks of life," the CM said.

Stressing on establishment of new units in the packaging sector, he said: "No matter how exceptional a product is, if its appearance is substandard, it will struggle to compete in the market. The initial impression of a product is created by its packaging. People get attracted to well-packaged products."

Underlining his vision for Gorakhpur's transformation, the CM said, "Jungle Kaudia Bypass from Kalesar, once a dream, is now a reality. AIIMS has been established in Gorakhpur, and BRD Medical College has been upgraded. The fertilizer factory has resumed operations. Gorakhpur now boasts of four universities. Recently, the govt approved the establishment of a veterinary university, which will eventually be upgraded to a full-fledged university. An Atal Residential School has been constructed in Sahjanwa and a Sarvodaya Vidyalaya has been established in Harpur."

The CM underlined the importance of skill development through NIELIT Skill Development Training Centre in GIDA.
