

34 projects worth ₹3,585 crore to be launched in GBC

Lucknow: As many as 34 new projects to the tune of Rs 3,585.85 crore would be added to the profile of Uttar Pradesh Defence Industrial Corridor (UPDIC) in the upcoming ground breaking ceremony, an official spokesperson said on Wednesday.

“These projects are spread across Aligarh, Jhansi, Kanpur and Lucknow nodes of the corridor and would generate over 8,530 employment opportunities,” they said.

Among major companies which have proposed investment in defence industrial corridor include BrahMos Aerospace and Areolloy Technologies at Lucknow, Bharat Dynamics Limited, Armoured Vehicles Nigam Limited, Tata Technologies Limited, Global Engineers Limited and WB Electronics India Limited at Jhansi, Adani

Defence Systems and Technologies Limited, Ananth Technologies and Genser Aerospace at Kanpur, Anchor Research Labs LLP and Amitec Electronics at Aligarh.

These investors have either established their units or are in the process of implementing their projects.

They also said that the current surge in investment and investors aligns with the government's indigenisation policy, emphasizing the manufacturing of 509 items on the positive list and 4,666 Line-Replaceable Units that will be compulsorily manufactured in India, translating into a total home-grown business of Rs 1,75,000 crore.

“UP Defence Industrial Corridor is transforming Uttar Pradesh into a major hub for defence and aerospace manufacturing, contributing to India's self-reliance and economic growth. The Yogi government's commitment to creating a supportive ecosystem and fostering innovation is attracting leading players and propelling the corridor's success,” the spokesperson said.
