Noida to soon have 'Korean' & 'Japanese' cities

Noida: Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA) has decided to set aside two sectors for 'Japanese' and 'Korean' industrial cities – where companies from these two countries will set up electronic manufacturing units, reports Aditya Dev. While 'Japanese City'

will come up in Sector 5A off the Yamuna eway, where 395 hectares are being acquired, 'Korean City' will be set up on 365 hectares in Sector 4A. The accessibility to the Noida International Airport in Jewar — barely 10km away is expected to give these two projects a boost in terms of connectivity. Arun Vir Singh, authority CEO, said the two electronic hubs would have firms manufacturing chips, semiconductors, AI equipment and cameras.
