A dream project: Rajnath; New India's train of progress running fast, says Yogi

LUCKNOW: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday virtually inaugurated the much-awaited redeveloped Gomti Nagar station and the renovation/ building of 73 other railway stations and 267 road over bridges/underpasses in Uttar Pradesh.

Defence minister Rajnath Singh was present in person at the inaugural event on the new station premises.

The station's inauguration was part of over 2000 railway infrastructure projects nationwide worth over Rs 41,000 crore for which the PM laid the foundation stone. This was done under the Viksit Bharat Viksit Railways event.

New trains from Gomti Nagar station

Railways has also prepared a plan to run new trains from the Gomti Nagar railway station. In the coming days, the Dehradun Vande Bharat Express will run from Gomti Nagar terminal. "Its proposal has been sent to the Railway Board," DRM, Lucknow NER, Aditya Kumar.

"Apart from this, there is a plan to run new trains from Gomti Nagar for Bihar, WB, Delhi, Mumbai and North East. Trains for Katra and Jagannath Puri will also run from the terminal," the divisional railway manager added.

OUTER RING ROAD, BRAHMOS UNIT TO BE INAUGURATED IN MAR: RAJNATH

LUCKNOW: Defence minister and Lucknow MP Rajnath Singh on Monday said the 104-km Outer Ring Road and the Brah-Mos unit in Lucknow will be inaugurated in March.

"The work on the Outer Ring Road is in full swing and after its recent inspection I have reached the conclusion that it is going to be completed in the next 2-3 days," he said. "The road will be inaugurated in the second week of March by PM during nationwide inauguration of several projects by him," Singh added at the Gomti Nagar station event.

This road will help decongest the city, he added.

"Once inaugurated, people travelling from across India to Lucknow will be able to enter their desired area, instead of having to enter the city. In the coming two years, eight-nine flyovers will be ready," he said.

The BrahMos missile unit will be inaugurated in next 10-15 days before announcement of election dates, he said. "No one knew that BrahMos would be made in Lucknow. While BrahMos missile (unit) is a significant development for the city, I pray that we may never have occasion to use it (missile)," he added. HTC
