

Pvt industrial park in Knp to create 2.5L jobs

Lucknow: A private industrial park planned in Kanpur Nagar at an investment of Rs 5850 crore is expected to provide employment to 2.5 lakh people, an official spokesperson said here on Tuesday.

“The project was launched during the groundbreaking ceremony on Feb 19 when the state govt unveiled over 14,000 projects worth over Rs 10 lakh crore. The list included ‘bhumi-poojan’ for a private industrial park in Kanpur Nagar. The project is initiated through Mega Leather Cluster Development (UP) Limited,” the spokesperson said. They added that once the project is completed, 2.5 lakh will get employment from it, which is highest among all projects launched during the GBC 4.0. The spokesperson also noted that

408 companies invested Rs 25,339 crore in Kanpur Nagar. The list includes Obdu Group’s digital Health subsidiary which is establishing artificial intelligence-based village health centres in several cities across the state.

These centres will function as digital doctor clinics, offering a range of health facilities to patients through telemedicine. The initiative with an estimated cost of Rs 3,350 crore will provide employment to more than 70,000 people. Starting with Bulandshahr, this will be implemented in other districts like Lucknow, Prayagraj, Fatehpur, Gonda, Bahraich, Kannauj, Kanpur, Sitapur, Hardoi, Rae Bareilly, Mirzapur, Ghazipur, Varanasi, Shahjahanpur, Banda, Hamirpur, Pratapgarh, Bhadohi, Kaushambi, Chitrakoot, and Gorakhpur.
