

Six districts in UP surpass GBC targets

Lucknow: As many as six districts have surpassed their targets for investment by achieving a 100% success rate. The districts are Chandauli, Hardoi, Amethi, Bareilly, Gonda and Fatehpur.

Sharing this information here on Friday, a govt spokesperson said that last year, the Yogi govt received investment proposals exceeding Rs 38 lakh crore through the Global Investors Summit (GIS). The govt is gearing up to conduct groundbreaking ceremony to bring the large-scale projects out of these proposals on the ground. "Each district has been assigned a target for this purpose. The districts have prepared various projects for investment through ground verification, land facilitation, and GBC tagging. Due to efforts of all the districts, projects amounting to over Rs 7.25 lakh crore are prepared for GBC till Jan 23, 2024 and this figure is set to increase as the date is yet to be announced officially," they said.

Sharing details, officials in the industry department pointed out that Chandauli stands out as the first among the six districts that successfully achieved the 100% target. "Having signed a total of 264 MoUs valued at over Rs 39,000 crores, Chandauli had a GBC target of Rs 20,000 crore. Remarkably, Chandauli has made 52 projects worth more than Rs 23,000 crore ready for GBC. This amount is 116% of the given target," they said.
