

Top 5 food processing projects set to create over 3,000 jobs in UP

Lucknow: The top five food processing projects, launched at the recent ground breaking ceremony, are set to create 3,000 jobs, said a govt spokesperson, on Wednesday. "The GBC 4.0 saw initiation of investment of over Rs 60,000 crore in the food processing sector of UP. Of the total, the top five projects are expected to generate over 3,000 employment opportunities, in Bijnor, Muzaffarnagar, Sandila, Bareilly and Baghpat districts. Besides, various major companies are investing in food processing in other districts too and will create thousands of job opportunities in the state," the spokesperson said.

Listing details, they informed that Coca-Cola is establishing its largest bottling SLMG (sugar syrup, jui-

ce manufacturing, pulping extraction and bottling) unit in UP, valued at Rs 509 crore, which will create about 275 jobs in Bijnor.

Similarly, Reliance Beverage Pvt Ltd, is setting up its beverage manufacturing unit in Muzaffarnagar at a cost of Rs 600 crore, which will generate 500 jobs.



The project is associated with development of a beverage manufacturing facility near Purkaji in Muzaffarnagar, under the joint venture of Bharatiya Beverages Private Limited and Reliance Retail Ventures Limited.

Balaji wafer is investing Rs 500 crore to set up its integrated food processing unit for the production of potato wafers and traditional Indian snacks in the industrial sector of Sandila, Haridwar.
