

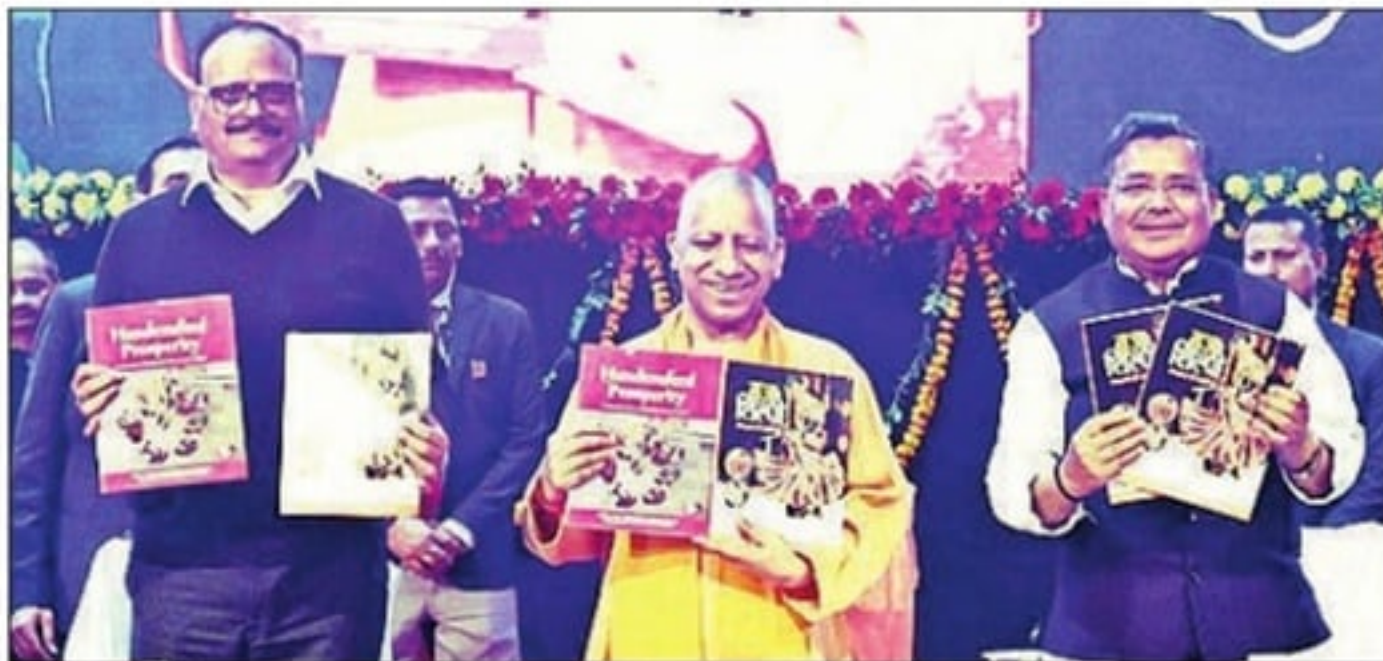
In a major boost, CM launches ₹2,758-crore tourism projects
