

UP dashboard to monitor \$1 trillion goal

Lucknow: A centralised dashboard will be set up at the Chief Minister's office to review the goals being achieved under the 1 trillion-dollar economy vision.

Yogi Adityanath's office has prepared a list of 96 key performance indicators (KPIs) that are being added to the dashboard along the parameters that will be regularly updated.

A total of 19 departments have to provide the required data, out of which a meeting of the housing department took place on Monday. Details of the land bank, number of approved layouts, number of non-residential maps sanctioned,

total unplanned land available are some points that have been sought by the team which is putting the dashboard together.

"KPIs will be integrated with the CM Darpan dashbo-

ard as it will be possible for the team working on the 1 USD goal to monitor the progress being made by different departments in a centralised manner," said the officer.

Govt has also sought details of the total unsold housing and non-housing plots available in 29 UP cities under the jurisdiction of local development authorities. Similarly, increase in installed capacity of renewable energy, milk processed by organised sector, increase in industrial consumption of electricity, number of new electricity meters provided to industrial units, total credit inflow against home loan, outstanding credit to MSMEs, feed production in state, increase in number of

hatcheries, total cess collected for labour welfare activities for construction work, number of students getting placed in private sector from polytechnics, number of commercial vehicles registered, permits issued to private bus operators are among the some indicators which would be available soon.

Prof Manoj Kumar Agarwal, faculty at LU economics department, said, "Besides focus on boosting economic activity in the state, govt should also include informal businesses and trade activities into the mainstream to achieve the USD 1 trillion economy goal. Some of the parameters being set forth would help in achieving that."
