

Project will tap into upcoming def corridor

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The agencies have been given the task of establishing BIDA City as a self-sustainable, happy and healthy investment destination. The project, only the second industrial city to be developed in UP after Noida, which was established in 1976, will be spread over an area of 35,300 acre for which work is on to acquire land from 33 villages. So

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far, 4,100 acres land has been acquired," Singh said.

The two firms have been asked to ensure that the masterplan keeps in mind land allocation for industries like warehouse and logistics, food processing, manufacturing, semi-conductor, renewable energy, electric vehicles, defence sector and automobiles. The project is expected to provide a massive boost to the Bundelkhand region, traditionally one of the most backward areas of UP. The project will also tap into the upcoming defence corridor, one of the two that are being developed in India at present.

BIDA will be headquartered in Jhansi. The Authority's website has also gone live now.
