The Agra Development Authority (ADA) is set to kickstart a mega infrastructural project with the construction of a state-of-the-art logistics hub in Mudhera village, situated southeast of the Gwalior Road in the city of the Taj.

The project, estimated to cost Rs 570 crore, aims to significantly enhance the region's logistics and transportation capabilities.

"The board has passed the proposal for the logistics hub in Mudhera. Seed Capital is needed for the purchase of land, and the proposal will be sent to the government for approval", Shraddha Shandilya, Secretary of ADA, said. "Once the necessary approvals are obtained, the land acquisition process will begin, paving the way for this transformative project."
