

6.5 lakh youths in UP got govt jobs in 7yrs

7K Received Job Letters On July 10

Lucknow: The UP govt claims to have provided more than 6.5 lakh jobs since 2017.

Most recently, the CM handed over appointment letters to 7,720 persons for the post of Lekhpal on Jul 10. A govt spokesperson said the CM will soon be distributing appointment letters to successful candidates in other departments too under Mission Rozgar.

“Since forming the govt for a second term in 2022, the CM has distributed appointment letters at various programmes. He has also urged public representatives to encourage the newly appointed youths in their districts, so as to motivate other aspiring candidates too,” the spokesperson said.

The CM has said under the new National Education

Policy implemented in 2020, govt is providing youth with the opportunity to pursue job-oriented courses in addition to regular curriculum and get prepared for the job market. State govt is using a similar pattern in secondary education schools as well, providing students with access to certificate courses related to paramedical, drone technology, data analysis, 3D printing, etc, in addition to the regular curriculum.

Recounting occasions on which the CM has distributed appointment letters, the official said the CM gave appointment letters to 39 SDMs, 41 deputy superintendents of police, 16 treasurer and local officers selected by Uttar Pradesh Public Service Commission, 852 appoin-

tees in various positions of UPPCL, 141 for dentists in the medical department, 391 for Ayurvedic medical officers in the AYUSH department, 14 for review officers in the Secretariat, 42 for assistant prosecution officers in home department, 123 for junior engineers in the housing department, 210 for junior engineers in irrigation department and nine for inspectors in the state office inspection directorate, Prayagraj.

In 2023, the CM handed out appointment letters to 7,182 ANM health workers, 1,442 newly selected staff nurses at SGPGI. On Jul 18, appointment letters were also given to 1,573 ANMs selected by the UP Subordinate Services Selection Commission, 1,148 to various posts in Lok Bhawan, 227 constables, 199 review officers and assistant review officers, 183 junior assistants in the transport department, and 128 junior assistants in the election department. Another 2,673 candidates received appointment letters in Jul 2023 and almost 800 persons more by the end of the year.
