Lucknow: A delegation of Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) led by its chairperson Anil Kumar Jain met chief secretary Manoj Kumar Singh in Lucknow and discussed the importance of promotion of natural gas as a cleaner fuel for both domestic and industrial purposes.
