395 bridges constructed in UP between 2017-2024

LUCKNOW: The Yogi Adityanath government has accorded top priority to infrastructural development across the state by focusing on construction of bridges to strengthen connectivity.

According to the Uttar Pra-

desh State Bridge Corporation Limited, 395 bridges have been constructed between 2017 and 2024. Out of this, construction of 270 river bridges, 115 rail overbridges, and 10 flyovers has been completed between 2018 and 2024.

Furthermore, in the ongoing financial year 2024-25, the construction of 259 bridges is underway with the state government's focus on completing 97 of them within this financial year.

According to the Bridge Corporation, 54 bridges were completed in 2017-18, including 38 river bridges, 15 rail overbridges (ROBs), and one flyover.

In 2018-19, a total of 48 bridges were completed, including 26 river bridges, 20 ROBs, and two flyovers.

In 2019-20, 48 bridges were completed, including 38 river bridges, nine ROBs, and one flyOUT OF 395, CONSTRUCTION OF 270 RIVER BRIDGES, 115 RAIL OVERBRIDGES, AND 10 FLYOVERS HAS BEEN COMPLETED

In 2020-21, 46 bridges were completed, including 26 river bridges, 17 ROBs, and three flyovers.

Similarly, in 2021-22, 72 bridges were completed, including 55 river bridges, 15 ROBs, and two flyovers.

In 2022-23, 72 bridges were completed, including 55 river bridges, 16 ROBs, and one flyover.

In 2023-24, a total of 55 bridges were completed, including 32 river bridges and 23 ROBs.

In the year 2024-25, out of the 126 projects, 51 are river bridges, 116 are rail overbridges, and 17 are flyovers. Of these, 51 river bridges, 53 rail overbridges, and 3 flyovers are expected to be completed in the ongoing financial year 2024-25.
