

CM zeroes in on 10 key areas for \$1 trillion economy goal

Emphasis On Law & Order, Agriculture

Lucknow: Chief minister Yogi Adityanath has instructed officials to develop a detailed action plan, focusing on 10 crucial sectors, to achieve state's one trillion-dollar economy goal, an official spokesperson said on Friday.

"During the supplementary budget discussion in the House, the chief minister outlined the necessary steps to drive UP towards becoming a one trillion-dollar economy, focusing on 10 key sectors. To accomplish this ambitious

target, he has directed officials to prioritise these sectors and promote coordinated efforts among all essential departments involved in the state's economic development," the spokesperson said.

The primary emphasis will be on "law and order, agricultural production, social security, infrastructure and industrial development, urban development, rural development, medical and health services, education, tourism and

culture and revenue collection. These areas will be pursued with a mission-mode approach over the next three years," he said.

Each of these sectors has been assigned to a designated cabinet minister, supported by experienced officers at the additional chief secretary level. CM Yogi has ordered the creation of both short-term and long-term action plans for each sector. To ensure effective implementation, the CM will personally oversee the progress of these plans, he said.

Having completed its 7-year tenure, the Yogi govt is now concentrating on a significant objective for the next three years. The govt has already achieved success in infrastructure, law and order, traffic connectivity and employment, he

said.

The govt has established a strong foundation for its goal of transforming UP into a one trillion-dollar economy. A significant indicator of this progress is the substantial increase in the state's Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP), which reached Rs 25.48 lakh crore in 2023-24, up from Rs 22.58 lakh crore in 2022-23, he said.

In 2023-24, UP's economy experienced an 8% growth. This positive trend results from the govt's strategic efforts over the past seven years, and it is expected to continue growing further, he said.

As Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said, if India is a bright spot on the global stage today, UP is positioned to play a crucial role in driving the country's growth, he said.
