

CM urges swift start for new medical and homeopathic colleges in Varanasi

Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath directed the prompt initiation of construction for a proposed medical college in Pandeypur and a homeopathic college in Pindara. During a review meeting at the Circuit House in Varanasi, CM emphasised the need for expeditious and high-quality completion of ongoing development projects.

He stressed the importance of maintaining strict

law enforcement and taking decisive action against professional and habitual criminals. He called for a focused approach to ensure the safety of women and children and

urged the police to act swiftly on any criminal reports. Yogi directed the removal of long-standing personnel from various departments, including the Varanasi Development Authority (VDA) and the municipal corporation, to streamline processes and simplify map approvals. He highlighted the need for technology integration to enhance efficiency in development works and urged the creation of model self-sufficient gram panchayats.

In response to the pro-

posed police recruitment exam, the CM called for transparency and integrity. He also instructed officials to hold regular public hearings, engage with citizens, address their issues promptly, and ensure proper conduct in government departments. He also inaugurated the dialysis department at the 108-year-old Shri Ram Lakshmi Narayan Marwari Hindu Hospital in Varanasi. Yogi commended the hospital's initiative to offer dialysis services at an affordable rate of Rs 500.
