

LDA to acquire land for three key projects

Lucknow: The Lucknow Development Authority will set up camps from Aug to expedite land acquisition for the proposed Wellness City, IT City, and Education City projects under the Mohan Road Scheme.

LDA vice chairperson Prathamesh Kumar formed committees to implement these schemes by engaging with farmers and landowners in villages. The land will be purchased by mutual agreement and action will be taken against illegal construction within the purview of the scheme.

The proposed Wellness City is planned on approximately 1,200 acres in the villages of Bakkas, Chaurahia, Chaurasi, Dularmau, and Noorpur Behta along Sultanpur Road. While the IT City will be developed on around 1,710 acres in the villages of Bakkas, Sonai Kanjehra, Sikan-darpur Amoliya, Siddhpura, Parehta, Paharnagar Tikaria, Rakibabad, Mohari Khurd, Khujauli and Bhatwara between Sultanpur Road and Kisan Path.
