UP needs additional 11,500km of NH: Yogi to Gadkari at Delhi meet

'Govt Land To Be Provided Free Of Cost For Expansion'

Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Monday said that though the national highways have expanded in UP at a brisk rate in the past seven years, the state still needs 11,500 km more to cover its entire population.

At a review meeting on national highway-related projects held at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi, he assured Union minister for road transport and highways, Nitin Gadkari, all help for the expansion of NH stretches in the state.

He assured the minister that the process of expand-
