LUCKNOW: The Amausi industrial area, a prominent industrial hub in the state capital housing manufacturing plants of several multinational companies, is set to undergo a complete makeover under the Atal Industrial Infrastructure Mission.

The Yogi Adityanath government has sanctioned ₹53.11 crore for the complete revamp of the Amausi industrial area. The project, to be executed by the Uttar Pradesh State Industrial Development Authority (UPSIDA), will include drainage system improvements, desilting chambers, and the establishment of a cutting-edge Integrated Control and Com-

PROPOSED PROJECTS

- Upgrading 4.23 km of roads, including widening of existing roads and constructing 800 metres of new paved roads.
- Construction of 98 desilting chambers, 7 culverts, and a 2.89 km-long Dal drainage line.
- Installation of EV charging stations, new entry gates, bus shelters, and street benches.
- Integrated Control and Command Centre; establishment of a state-of-the-art facility for centralised management
- Installation of advanced CCTV cameras and upgrades to the Common Facility Centre (CFC) for improved
- Development of 73,044 square metres of green space with grass, trees, and plants, along with rainwater harvesting systems for gardening along entry roads
- Upgrading electricity systems at a cost of ₹13 crore, including the installation of underground 33 kV and 11 kV cables, streetlights, high mast poles with tricolour lighting, and LED facade lighting to enhance the area's For representation only aesthetics.
