
New industrial hub to be developed in Shankargarh

PRAYAGRAJ: An industrial area is set to be developed in Shankargarh, located in the trans-Yamuna region of Prayagraj. Following a survey, the department concerned has identified land for the project.

Once formalities are completed, work will begin to establish the necessary infrastructure for the industrial area. Officials believe this initiative will boost employment opportunities in the trans-Yamuna region. It's important to note that the central government approved the establishment of 12 industrial smart cities, which includes Prayagraj. An industrial area is already established in Naini, also in the trans-Yamuna region. Shankargarh has been deemed suitable for industrial develop-

ment due to the availability of large tracts of land.

Additionally, the silica sand found in Shankargarh is in high demand, even internationally. Given the space available, solar plants may also be installed in the area. Shankargarh, which borders Madhya Pradesh, enjoys good connectivity to neighboring cities. Deputy commissioner of industries Sharad Tandon stated that plans are in place to develop an industrial area over 900 acres of land in the Bara tehsil of Shankargarh.
