

UP to host 255 biz honchos at Semicon

Yogi: Event To Put UP On Global Stage

800 global cos to be part of Electronica

Lucknow: As many as 872 exhibitors from across the globe will be participating in Electronica India 2024, which begins at the India Expo Mart, Greater Noida, on Wednesday, an official spokesperson said.

"The international trade fair, one of the largest in South Asia, will showcase electronic components, systems, applications and solutions from 872 exhibitors from across the globe. It will

also boost UP's global image," the spokesperson said.

Adding that leading companies from 24 countries, including the USA, Taiwan, Turkey and Singapore, will take part in the event, the spokesperson said that as the host state, UP will highlight its investor-friendly policies in the electronics sector, the development of electronic clusters and programmes designed to attract investment. "Special attention will be given to the structured framework un-

der the FDI policy, providing detailed information on incentives and investment processes. This event will elevate UP's global standing and open up new opportunities for investment and employment in the state," they said. Officials said that Electronica India 2024 will spotlight over 52 key sectors in the electronics industry, including 3D printing, additive manufacturing, automotive and EV technology, component mounting, coil wire production, display

and LED, electronic manufacturing services, hybrid component manufacturing, semiconductors and wireless technology.

Electronica will host 49 leading companies, such as ABC Taiwan Electronics Corp, a prominent Taiwanese semiconductor manufacturer, alongside 23 firms from the USA, including AI Technology Inc and 24 companies from China, including Messe Munchen Shanghai Corporation Limited.

Lucknow: India's bid for semiconductor manufacturing has made UP the host state of Semicon 2024. Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath is seeing the event as an opportunity to position UP on global stage, an official spokesperson said on Tuesday.

Camping in Noida, where the event will take place from Wednesday, the CM oversaw preparations. The opening ceremony of Semicon India 2024 will take place on Wednesday, with Prime Minister Narendra Modi and CM Yogi in attendance. Electronica India 2024 and Productronica India 2024 will also be held.

A spokesperson said that CM Yogi will participate in two one-on-one sessions with investors during the event. Additionally, he will inaugurate both the Work Force Pavilion and the Development Pavilion.

Semicon will see the participation of 255 representatives from 17 countries, including major industry players from the United States, Japan, South Korea and India.

'Productronica to boost UP's global presence'

Lucknow: Strengthening UP's position in the global market, the UP govt is set to host Semicon India 2024, Electronica India 2024 and Productronica India 2024.

Reviewing the preparations for the event that begins on Wednesday, chief minister Yogi Adityanath reiterated the state's commitment towards scripting the UP-growth story and ensuring that it becomes a one trillion-dollar economy by the end of 2027.

Officials engaged with the preparations said that

the three international trade fairs, dedicated to electronics development and production, will be held from Sept 11 to 13 at India Expo Mart, Greater Noida, covering 35,000 sqmt with 589 exhibitors from around the world.

The event will showcase UP's expanding role in the technology sector, with a focus on fostering an investment-friendly environment, good governance and sector-driven policies, officials said.

UP is already a leader in mobile manufacturing and plays a pivotal role in electronics production, officials said, adding that through Productronica India 2024, the state aims to strengthen its global market presence while unlocking new opportunities for investment and job creation.

Later, an official spoke-

person said that substantial efforts are being made to expand the semiconductor sector, attract leading chip manufacturing companies and establish multiple clusters for electronics manufacturing across the state.

"The govt is prioritising these initiatives, with Noida and Greater Noida leading the way. These regions have made Uttar Pradesh a significant contributor to the nation's electronics industry, accounting for 55% of mobile manufacturing and nearly 50% of mobile component production in India," the spokesperson said.
