GORAKHPUR: Stating that Uttar Pradesh is seeing an investment rush because of a safe environment, chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Sunday said the state government's zero-tolerance policy towards crime has disturbed those who once saw crime as a profession.

He was speaking at the inauguration of a new soft drink bottling and dairy product plant by Varun Beverages, a franchisee of PepsiCo, which was set up with an investment of Rs 1,170 crore near the Gorakhpur Link Expressway at the Gorakhpur Industrial Development Authority (GIDA).
