

Global Co to set up domestic biogas plants

Lucknow: Sistema.bio, a global social enterprise, known for its innovative biogas technology, will set up 2,250 domestic biogas plants in UP.

The biogas plants will be set up in rural areas in Varanasi, Ayodhya, Gonda, and Gorakhpur.

The department of environment, forest and climate change has granted approval to the project. The cost of a plant is Rs 39,300.

“The beneficiary farmer will have to pay only Rs 3,990,” said the minister of state for environment, forest and climate change (independent charge) AK Saxena.

The rest of the amount will be arranged through the central financial assistance and carbon credits. The ministry of new and renewable energy set the target of 2,250 domestic biogas plants in the state for 2024-25. The plants will also provide organic bio-manure for farming, besides the biogas for cooking.
