
YEIDA plans bus service from Noida airport

Noida: The Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA) is planning to launch a dedicated bus service to connect the upcoming Noida International Airport with nearby cities, including Delhi, Ghaziabad, Noida, and Greater Noida.

The service will be operated by a private agency and will enhance transportation to the airport, set to become operational by April next year. YEIDA officials have pro-

posed to start the service with 100 buses initially, with plans to gradually increase the fleet to 250 buses based on demand. An RFP will be issued soon.

The service will not be linked to the PM e-bus scheme, which will provide 100 buses for urban connectivity in the region, and will solely focus on airport connectivity, facilitating seamless travel for passengers across Delhi-NCR and west UP. YEIDA CEO Arun Vir Singh said, "Our goal is to have the bus service operational by the time the airport opens next April. This will ensure convenient and efficient transport for passengers travelling to and from the airport, connecting it directly with major cities."
