

₹17,865 crore supplementary budget to push power & infra

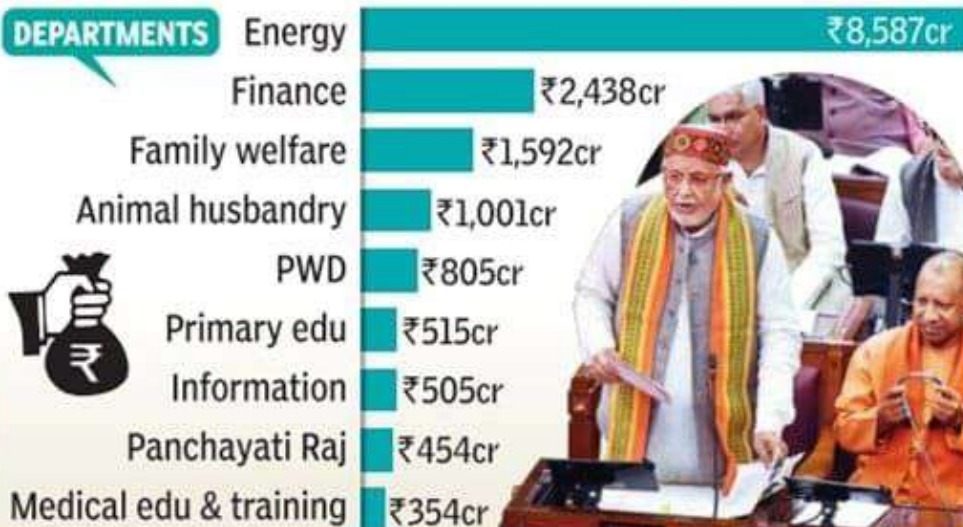
Lucknow: With focus on power sector and infrastructure development, the Yogi Adityanath govt on Tuesday tabled its second supplementary budget of this fiscal worth Rs 17,865.72 crore. This includes fresh proposals worth Rs 790 crore.

The Yogi government had presented its main budget over Rs 7.36 lakh crore in Feb this year. Later, on July 30, a supplementary budget of Rs 12,209 crore was tabled. The second supplementary budget thus accounts for 2.42% of the original budget.
