
## Yogi bats for centres of excellence in tech univs to promote innovation

Lucknow: In a review of the UP Innovation Fund, which has been set up to promote innovation in the state, chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Monday said that centres of excellence should be set up in the three technical universities in the state to promote innovation.
