LUCKNOW: The chief executive officer of Invest UP, Abhishek Prakash, has emphasised the importance of collaboration between industries, government and academic institutions like the IET to fully leverage the benefits of the Uttar Pradesh Industrial Investment and Employment Promotion Policy - 2022.

He explained that students were working on global challenges such as lithium-ion batter-

ies, robotics, and green hydrogen projects under the guidance of faculty members.

He also pointed out the institute's willingness to partner with industries to establish centres of excellence (CoEs) aimed at advancing both the institution and Uttar Pradesh's development.

They also discussed the research and development centres, hackathons, grand challenges, upskilling facilities, research laboratories, product testing capabilities, project viability, and regional infrastructure expertise as key areas for promoting CoEs.
