

Maharajganj tops in UP in finishing devpt works

Lucknow: Committed to ensuring timely completion of development projects and the swift resolution of revenue-related matters across the state, the Yogi govt on Sunday carried out a review of the revenue department related matters.

Going through the district-wise reports submitted for the last month, performance and benchmark achieved by 75 districts across the state were monitored through the CM dashboard. Progress being made while executing development works was also taken into account.

According to report, Maharajganj secured the top spot in the state for development works and at resolving revenue matters, while Bahraich stood at the second spot. District magistrate of Maharajganj Anunaya Jha gave credit to the guidance being provided by chief minister Yogi Adityanath. He said, "Development projects and works

are being executed swiftly and special drives are being organised to resolve long-pending revenue cases, particularly those older than five years, on a priority basis. Focus and dedication of the entire team enabled Maharajganj to achieve the first place in the state with a remarkable score of 89.20% score in November." Jha noted that Maharajganj has been among the top five districts during the past five

months.

Similarly, Bahraich district magistrate Monika Rani said, "The district secured second place with an impressive score of 89.10%." She emphasized that Bahraich is making rapid progress in implementing administrative reforms and delivering govt schemes effectively on the ground. The district's efforts in swiftly resolving revenue matters and its initiatives to support farmers and small traders, have been instrumental in achieving this mi-

lestone, she added.

Hamirpur stood at the third spot with a score of 88.80%, followed by Ambedkar Nagar and Bulandshahr; at the fourth and fifth positions with 88.30%. Kushinagar ranked sixth with 88.20%, Sambhal seventh with 88%, Shamli eighth with 87.80%, Basti ninth with 87.70% and Banda at the tenth spot with a score of 87.10%.

It is worth noting that Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath established the CM dashboard as a tool to monitor district-level development project to ensure the effective delivery of govt schemes and expedite resolution of revenue-related issues. The monthly report is based on 10 key performance indicators.

Under the leadership of the CM, several initiatives are being implemented in an efficient manner. These include resolving land disputes raised by the farmers, digitising revenue records and providing benefits of govt schemes to the underprivileged.
