

Rail Neer plant to come up in Prayagraj

Lucknow: The Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) is set to establish a Rail Neer bottled water plant in Saraswati High-Tech City, Prayagraj, said an official spokesperson on Friday. The Uttar Pradesh State Industrial Development Authority

(UPSIDA) has allocated 2.5 acres for the project.

“The plant, coming up at an estimated investment of Rs 25 crore, will have a production capacity of 1 lakh litres per day, significantly boosting the availability of packaged drinking water,” the spokesperson said.

IRCTC already operates several Rail Neer

plants across India, with two currently functioning in Uttar Pradesh — one in Amethi and the other in Hapur.

UPSIDA CEO Mayur Maheshwari stated, “This project will not only promote industrial development but also play a key role in providing safe drinking water to railway passengers.”
