
CM Yogi: Upcoming Lucknow Textile Park to create 50K jobs

Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Saturday led a roadshow to meet potential investors for the upcoming textile and apparel park at Lucknow-Hardoi border, being developed under the PM Mitra Scheme. The govt also signed two MoUs worth Rs 700 crore during the investors' meet.

"The textile park would establish UP as a textile hub and create over 50,000 jobs," he said. He highlighted UP's position as India's largest consumer market with a population of 25 crore and said the state has also served the needs of people from Nepal, Bhutan, Bihar, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Uttarakhand.

He also announced that the state govt will establish 10 new textile parks named after Sant Kabir Das and two leat-

her parks in honour of Sant Ravidas.

The CM also distributed an incentive amount of Rs 210 crore to 80 investors under the state's Textile and Apparel Policy 2017. He said Rs 3,800 crore worth of investment proposals were already received under 83 MoUs.
