**Lucknow:** The UP govt has approved a state-of-the-art central office complex for the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA).

Spanning across 27,800 square meters, the complex will be located on plot number F-4 in Sector-18 of Gautam Budh Nagar, barely 100 metres from the Yamuna Expressway.

## ₹1.28 crore approved for women shelters

**Lucknow:** The state govt's plan to set up women shelters, called Shakti Sadan, is in its final stages with the approval of a fund of Rs 1.28 crore for the project. Under this initiative, centres will be established in 10 districts under the Mission Shakti project.

"These centres will work towards ensuring the safety, empowerment, and rehabilitation of women. Women in distress, including victims of domestic violence, natural disasters, and other vulnerable situations, will find protection and support here," said a govt spokesperson.

Each centre will have the capacity to accommodate 50 women. In addition to refuge and rehabilitation, they will also provide vocational training to help the women become independent. The shelters will be opened in Aligarh, Azamgarh, Kanpur Nagar, Chitrakoot, Jhansi, Basti, Gonda, Mirzapur, Varanasi, and Saharanpur. The scheme is being implemented with joint support from the central and state govts in a 60:40 funding ratio.

A woman provided shelter in any Shakti Sadan will also receive mental, physical, and legal support.
