

Uttar Pradesh unveils textile policies at Gartex Texprocess India 2025

The government of Uttar Pradesh has debuted new textile policies at Gartex Texprocess India 2025 as part of its push to become a \$1 trillion economy and attract global investment. Invest UP and the Directorate of Handloom & Textiles are representing the state at the trade event, highlighting new opportunities in the textile and garment sectors.



Speaking during the inaugural session, Shashank Chaudhary, ACEO of Invest UP, outlined the state’s economic transformation and strategic focus on infrastructure, skilled labour, and innovation. “Uttar Pradesh, home to a rich textile heritage from Banarasi weaves to Lucknow’s chikankari, is now combining tradition with modernity,” said Chaudhary, the UP government announced in a press release.
