
Boney Kapoor's firm submits layout of International Film City project to YEIDA

Lucknow: Bollywood film producer Boney Kapoor's company Bayview Projects LLP on Tuesday submitted the layout of the International Film City to the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA), an official statement issued here said.

YEIDA will now review the plan, and after necessary approvals, formal construction work will begin.

The International Film City is planned to be developed over 1,000 acres along the Yamuna Expressway at Sector-21 in Greater Noida. The first phase will kick off on 230 acres of land with an estimated investment

of Rs 1,510 crore, the statement said.

YEIDA Officer on Special Duty (OSD) Shailendra Bhatia said Kapoor, who has taken the responsibility of building the film city, submitted the complete layout of the project on behalf of his company. Now, the authority will review and examine the entire layout, after which they will give the necessary approval to start work, he said.

YEIDA CEO Arun Veer Singh said the construction will follow the agreement, and no changes will be accepted without approval. Separate no-objection certificates will be required for approvals like parking, landscaping, and gardening. PTI
