Lucknow/Mumbai, May 24, 2025: Uttar Pradesh showcased its commitment to industrial growth and textile innovation by actively participating in the three-day Gartex Texprocess India 2025 expo in Mumbai from May 22-24—India's leading platform for garment and textile machinery.
