

Kushinagar int'l airport gets licence for all-weather flights

Lucknow: The Kushinagar International Airport has been granted the Instrument Flight Rule (IFR) licence which will enable all-weather operations.

Until now the airport operated only under Visual Flight Rules (VFR), which limited flights to clear daytime conditions.
