

Uttar Pradesh leads nation in GST registrations

Uttar Pradesh has emerged as the leading state in Goods and Services Tax (GST) registrations across India, surpassing Maharashtra. Within the state, Gautam Buddha Nagar (Noida) holds the top position for the highest number of registered taxpayers. This trend is evident from the Central and State GST registration data released by the central authorities on July 1, 2025, covering figures up to June 30.

According to the statistics, Uttar Pradesh boasts 926,615 businesses registered under Central GST, the highest nationwide. These businesses contributed ₹15,713 crore in taxes in June alone. Maharashtra follows in second place with 771,529 Central



June collections hit ₹15,713 crore under CGST, ₹16,266 crore under state GST

GST registrations. For State GST registrations, Uttar Pradesh again leads with 1,099,850 businesses, depositing ₹16,266 crore in June. Maharashtra is second in State GST registrations as well, with 1,092,809 registered businesses.

Within Uttar Pradesh,

Gautam Buddha Nagar district leads with the highest number of GST registrations. It accounts for 112,348 Central GST registered businesses (86,772 in Noida and 22,253 in Greater Noida) and 114,674 State GST registered businesses (92,421 in Noida and 22,253 in Greater Noida). While the district sees the highest number of registrations and tax collections, it also reports the highest number of fraudulent companies.

Authorities are leveraging online systems to curb tax evasion. Firms that engage in tax evasion or fail to pay taxes on time are identified through the online portal. Despite reminders, non-compliant businesses are blacklisted, and teams initiate legal action to recover outstanding taxes.
