Yogi: Ensure accountability & quality of devpt projects

'Appoint Nodal Officer For Each Project'

Gorakhpur: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Sunday directed officials to ensure that all development projects are completed within the stipulated timeframe and there should be no compromise on quality.

Chairing a review meeting of ongoing projects at the Annexe Bhawan in Gorakhpur, the CM emphasized that nodal officers should be appointed for each project to monitor progress on a regular basis.

"Gorakhpur's development works have created a strong positive perception of the city across the country and must move forward without any hindrance," he said.

The CM made it clear that negligence on the part of contractors would invite strict action, and any compromise in quality or lapses

in execution would lead to accountability being fixed on the concerned officers.

He instructed the Gorakhpur DM to continuously seek updates from nodal officers and expedite key projects, ensuring timely and quality completion.

Yogi also reviewed health sector and reminded officials that encephalitis (JE and AES), once a curse for Purvanchal, has now been controlled due to sustained efforts, but constant vigilance is essential.

He emphasised the importance of public awareness and cleanliness drives in preventing dengue and seasonal diseases, with enhan-

ced publicity across all municipal bodies.

Reiterating his zero-tolerance policy, Yogi warned officials against allowing medical mafias to operate. "While mafia rule has been dismantled across Uttar Pradesh, strict vigilance is necessary to curb malpractices such as ambulance mafias and middlemen in hospitals. It should be ensured that such elements do not flourish and patients receive fair and transparent healthcare services."

Highlighting Gorakhpur's growing stature as a city competing with major smart cities, the CM stressed the need for smooth traffic management. He directed the traffic police and municipal corporation to work together to prevent congestion, prohibit stalls and carts on main roads, and provide proper rehabilitation to street yendors.

The CM reviewed initiatives for council schools and directed officials to ensure that the funds transferred to parents for uniform, bags, and shoes were properly utilized. "Children must attend schools in uniform, creating discipline and harmony," he said and sought information about the Bal Vatika facilities for pre-school children, terming them a commendable initiative.

He asked officials to involve public representatives for support. Reviewing Project Alankar for secondary schools, he instructed strict adherence to quality standards.

The CM reviewed progress of Godhdhoiya Nala project for waterlogging prevention and asked officials to accelerate work, making alternative arrangements during the rain. He also reviewed STP construction under Amrit Yojana.
