

Yogi: Our 'dharma' to restore UP's prime position in India's economy

Lucknow: Stressing that Uttar Pradesh's share in India's GDP should be proportionate to its share in population, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said here on Saturday that 'it was our dharma to restore the state's prime position in the country's economy, outlining his government's commitment and approach to making the state a fully developed state.

Thanking TOI for joining UP's development journey to

achieve the goal of Viksit UP-2047, the CM highlighted the state's progress over the past eight years, especially talking about law and order, better infrastructure, investments, and industrialisation.

Speaking at TOI's 'Viksit Uttar Pradesh: Vision 2047' conclave in Lucknow on Saturday, he emphasised on the need for a strong foundation on which the government

could build a developed state, the CM said that
