## Uttar Pradesh Showcases SAF Potential at Indian Sustainable Aviation Fuel Conclave & Awards 2025

## UP Positions Itself as India's Emerging Hub for Green Aviation Fuel

**New Delhi/Lucknow, 15 September 2025** — Uttar Pradesh made a strong pitch for sustainable investments at the *Indian Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) Conclave & Awards 2025* in New Delhi, highlighting its potential to emerge as a key hub for green aviation fuel production in India.

The event, which brought together industry leaders, global investors, and policymakers from aviation, energy, and industrial sectors, was attended by Union Civil Aviation Minister Shri Kinjarapu Rammohan Naidu and Union Petroleum & Natural Gas Minister Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, reaffirming the Government of India's commitment to clean energy and international collaboration.

On the sidelines of the conclave, Shri Chaudhary engaged in strategic discussions with H.E. Mr. Benedikt Hoskuldsson, Ambassador of Iceland to India, and Mr. Amar Singh Chandel, Vice President, EMBRAER, exploring opportunities to leverage Uttar Pradesh's strong agricultural base to build a green aviation ecosystem.
