Vision 2047: \$6T Growth via Edu-Health

The Uttar Pradesh government has unveiled its long-term roadmap for "Developed UP @2047," placing education and healthcare at the center of its strategy to achieve a \$6 trillion economy over the next 22 years. Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said the vision rests on building an "educated childhood and healthy families" as the foundation for sustainable growth.

The plan sets targets of covering 50% of households under medical insurance by



2030 and achieving universal coverage by 2047. It also prioritizes reducing maternal and infant mortality in line with SDG benchmarks. To expand health infrastructure, the roadmap includes two new

AIIMS, three pharma parks, and two medical device parks. The government also aims to raise health workforce density to 40 per 1,000 people, strengthen nutrition programs, promote medical tour-

ism, and advance health research.

To prepare a skilled global workforce, initiatives such as Gyandeeep and Yuva Shakti will scale up digital classrooms, edtech, and e-learning. The focus also includes strengthening foundational literacy and numeracy, teacher training, research and innovation, and equipping students

for Industry 4.0 with skilling and dual education models.

UP's education and health systems faced severe gaps before 2017, with poor facilities, high dropout rates, and weak healthcare services. In the past eight years, initiatives such as School Chalo Abhiyan and Sharda program have added over 40 lakh new enrollments, while RTE beneficiaries rose from 22,000 to 4.3 lakh. Operation Kayakalp has brought 19 basic facilities to schools, and Project Alankar upgraded infrastructure across secondary institutions.
