Yogi reviews Noida airport work as inauguration day inches closer

NEW DELHI/GREATER NOIDA: Uttar Pradesh chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Saturday reviewed work at Noida International Airport in Jewar and directed the concessionaire to

complete it as soon as possible. "The date for the inauguration will be finalised soon, and we have given the timelines to the concessionaire to complete the civil work and also obtain requisite approvals well in advance for the mega event," said RK Singh, chief executive officer of the Noida International Private Limited (NIAL), a state government agency formed to oversee the work.

The much awaited Noida International airport (NIA) may take another at least a month before it gets inaugurated, senior officials privy to the development said on Saturday. The greenfield airport was targeted to be inaugurated by the monthend, but officials have confirmed that the airport is under

LUCKNOW: Chief minister Yogi Adityanath called on President Droupadi Murmu, vice-president CP Radhakrishnan and Prime Minister Narendra Modi in Delhi on Saturday.

Though the Uttar Pradesh government described the meetings as courtesy calls, officials aware of the development aid the CM also invited Modi to inaugurate the Jewar airport, scheduled to be operational by November-end. He is also believed to have invited the PM to hoist the flag atop the Ram temple in Ayodhya.

On November 25, top BJP leaders will gather in Ayodhya, where a grandevent is planned on the lines of the Pran Pratishtha ceremony.

According to government sources, Adityanath also highsecurity arrangements, traffic management, and ongoing construction works.

Following the inspection, the chief minister chaired a high-level review meeting in the airport boardroom with senior officials from the district and police administration, Noida International Airport Limited (NIAL), and the airport construction agency. A presentation was made on project progress, upcoming action plans, and preparations for the inauguration, according to a PTI report.
