

UP's growth highlighted at Indo-US Eco Summit

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LUCKNOW: India is not just an emerging market, but an emerging model aligned with the aspirational vision of Viksit Bharat, said Union minister for commerce and industry Piyush Goyal on Tuesday at the Indo-US Economic Summit 2025 in New Delhi. Invest UP officials attended the event. Senior officials of the state government were also present.

Highlighting Uttar Pradesh's remarkable rise as a premier investment destination, Goyal noted the importance of ensuring that every investment yields meaningful outcomes and generates employment.
