## UP's pharmaceutical sector to get pharma park, med device hub

"These projects are designed to bring UP to the forefront of India's pharmaceutical and medical technology revolution. The upcoming infrastructure would not only attract toptier companies but also foster a vibrant innovation ecosystem," he told the gathering of researchers, academicians, and industry leaders.

He added that: "The 5000-acre pharma park will serve as a one-stop destination for manufacturing, research and formulation technologies. Similarly, the medical device manufacturing hub in Noida will be a game-changer in reducing India's dependence on imported equipment and boosting indigenous capability."

Singh added that the state's vision is aligned with national goals of self-reliance and technological advancement in healthcare.
