

UP's new export policy is bouquet of reforms: Nandi

Lucknow: State industrial development minister Nand Gopal Gupta 'Nandi' on Tuesday represented Uttar Pradesh at the Board of Trade meeting in New Delhi to sharpen UP's export push.

The meet was held under the chairmanship of Union commerce and industry minister Piyush Goyal. Minister of state Jitin Prasada was also in attendance.

Presenting the state's export roadmap, Nandi highlighted the gains made under the double-engine govt and reiterated UP's commitment to streng-

thening the national export ecosystem.

"Over the past eight years, UP's exports have risen from Rs 84,000 crore in 2018 to Rs 1.86 lakh crore now. Initiatives like the UP International Trade Show gave a major boost to local manufacturers and artisans, who secured advance orders from international buyers up to 2027," he said. Adding that to meet future targets, UP has notified its new Export Policy 2025-30, Nandi said: "The new policy is like a bouquet of reforms and incentive that would prove to be a milestone in raising UP's share in India's overall exports."
